This guided small group tour features the coastal cities of Seward and Homer, the bustling metropolitan community of Anchorage, the fertile Matanuska-Susitna Valley and the diverse wildlands of Denali National Park and the Kenai Peninsula. Discover the best of Alaska!

Day 1: Anchorage. Arrive Anchorage, shuttle service to hotel with afternoon at leisure.

Accommodation: Lakefront Hotel Anchorage or similar – 1 night

Day 2: Anchorage - Denali. Head north to Denali National Park and Preserve making a stop along the way at Iditarod Headquarters. (B)

Accommodation: Grizzly Bear Resort or similar – 2 nights

Day 3: Denali National Park. Board the Denali Park Transit Bus to travel 43 miles into Denali National Park to the East Fork River. On a clear day, the park affords views of Mt Denali and the Alaska Ranges and excellent wildlife viewing. This afternoon there is time for optional tours such as flight seeing, river rafting or hiking.

Day 4: Denali - Talkeetna - Wasilla. This morning, enjoy a tour of the Denali National Park Visitors Centre or take a scenic hike around Horseshoe Lake to watch for moose or beaver. This afternoon board the Denali Star train to Talkeetna. Explore the colourful town of Talkeetna on a guided walking tour before transferring to Wasilla.

Accommodation: Best Western Lake Lucille or similar, Wasilla – 1 night

Day 5: Wasilla - Homer. Leave the Matanuska Valley following the scenic Seward Highway along the picturesque Turnagain Arm before crossing the Kenai Peninsula and onto Homer. Enjoy many scenic stops along the way including a leisurely walk at Potter Marsh (B)

Accommodation: Aspen Suites Hotel or similar, Homer – 2 nights

Day 6: Homer. Enjoy a day at leisure to explore Homer and the surrounding area. Choose from optional excursions including Halibut fishing, bear viewing or a visit to the Alaskan Islands.

Day 7: Homer - Seward. Start the day with a visit to the local Farmers Market before departing Homer. Make a stop at the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge Visitor Centre before heading to Seward. Round out the day with an early evening walk to the toe of Exit Glacier and visit to Exit Glacier Visitor Centre.

Accommodation: Seward Windsong Lodge or similar, Seward – 2 nights

Day 8: Seward. Discover Kenai Fjords National Park on a fully narrated wildlife and glacier cruise. Take in the stunning scenery while keeping an eye out for marine sea life such as sea otters, sea lions, puffins and whales. With luck observe huge chunks of ice calving off a glacier. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure. (L)

Day 9: Seward - Anchorage. Head back to Anchorage this morning making a stop at the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Centre, the home to bison, caribou, moose, wolves, bears and many other indigenous animals. Enjoy a city tour of Anchorage before arriving to the hotel.

Accommodation: Lakefront Hotel Anchorage or similar – 1 night

Day 10: Anchorage. Tour Ends today with shuttle service available to the airport if required. (B)
