This tour takes you into the heart of the real Borneo, to Discover Sarawak, known as Bumi Kenyaland or "Land of the Hornbills". Wild Sarawak is a blend of tribal tradition and sprawling natural beauty. Journey into the untouched wilderness on a traditional longboat, experience the everyday living of the local Iban people and take a relaxing walking tour learning about the heritage of the capital Kuching.

Get up close and personal during feeding time with rehabilitated wild Orang Utans at Semmengok, snorkel amidst a wide variety of soft corals and colourful marine life on Satang Island and wonder at Mulu National Park. Relax at Damai Beach Resort at the end of your stay. Once visited, you will always remember the extraordinary natural wonders of this amazing, untouched part of Borneo.

Day 1: Australia - Kuching. Fly from Australia to Kuching via Kuala Lumpur.

Day 2: Arrive Kuching. Transfer to the hotel.

Accommodation: Grand Margherita Hotel, Kuching – 1 night

Day 3: Kuching - Engkari River. Journey overland from Kuching to Batang Ai, passing through Serian and a lunch stop at Lachau. Longboat ride across the Batang Ai Hydro Lake into the Engkari River, after a short journey arriving at the Ukom Longhouse. Enjoy a delicious fresh local dinner. Evening entertainment of traditional dancing and tuak or "rice wine". (B,L,D) Accommodation: Guesthouse with basic facilities, Engkari River -1 night

Day 4: Engkari River - Kuching. After breakfast, enjoy a blowpipe demonstration and take a walk through the forest with an Iban tracker, learning about the traditional uses of rainforest plants. Transfer back to Kuching. (B)

Accommodation: Grand Margherita Hotel, Kuching - 3 nights

Day 5: Kuching Heritage Trail & Semonggok Wildlife Rehabilitation Centre. Commence a walkabout tour of Kuching, visiting the "Tua Tek Kong" Chinese Temple and Chinese Historical Museum. Pass by many historical buildings built during the era of the Brooke Dynasty. Continue onto India Street, a shopping mall specialising in local and imported textiles then Gambier Street where your senses will be delighted with the aroma of Indian spices. Pass through Merdeka Square to St Thomas's Cathedral for a short visit. This afternoon visit the Semonggok Wildlife Rehabilitation centre for an unforgettable wildlife experience.

Day 6: Bako National Park Day Trip. Travel 1½ hours from Kuching by car and longboat to Bako National Park, which is home to seven distinct rainforest ecosystems, giving it a remarkable diversity. The park is home to the most famous resident, the proboscis monkeys as well as hundreds of bird species and fascinating plant life. Unique geological features mark the coastline, whilst well-marked trails lead to rugged jungle-covered hilltops and secluded beaches. (B,L)

Day 7: Kuching - Mulu. Transfer to the airport for the flight to Mulu. Met and transfer to Mulu National Park. After lunch trek 45 minutes on raised plank walk though rainforest to Lang Caves. Walk inside the cave passage of Deer Cave. Witness the daily exodus of thousands of bats at sunset before returning to the resort.

(B. Accommodation: Chalet, Mulu National Park – 2 nights

Day 8: Mulu. After breakfast, visit the education centre at Park Headquarters, then take a longboat ride up the Melinau River to explore wind caves and Clearwater caves. Lunch at Clearwater River and swim in crystal clear water before returning to the resort.

Day 9: Mulu - Kuching. After breakfast, transfer to the airport for return flight to Kuching Transfer to the hotel.

Accommodation: Grand Margherita Hotel, Kuching – 2 nights

Day 10: Kuching. Day at own leisure.

Day II: Kuching - Australia. Transfer to airport. Fly Kuching to Australia via Kuala Lumpur. **Day 12: Arrive Australia.**
