Enjoy the Best of Malawi Highlights on this 12 day itinerary. Fly into Chileka International Airport and transfer to Mkulumadzi situated right within Majete Wildlife Reserve, one of the outstanding success stories of African conservation. Continue to the stunning Satemwa Tea Estates for a two night stay, before travelling to Liwonde National Park to explore the wildlife this park has to offer. Enjoy the natural state of Mumbo Island Camp, located on the shores of Lake Malawi before spending the last three nights on Nankoma Island. This is truly a wild island paradise supporting some of the most diverse flora and fauna in Malawi.

Day 1: Blantyre - Majete Wildlife Reserve. Met and transferred from Chileka International Airport to Majete Wildlife Reserve for a two night stay. (D)

Accommodation: Mkulumadzi (Bush Suites), Majete Wildlife Reserve - 2 nights

Day 2: Majete Wildlife Reserve. Enjoy a full day of game viewing activities (game drives or walking safaris). Undiscovered by tourists, Majete is a true wilderness where every trip into the bush with a team of experienced guides will feel like an adventure. (B,L,D)

Day 3: Majete Wildlife Reserve - Satemwa Tea Estate. Enjoy a morning game viewing activity in Majete Wildlife Reserve before transfer to Satemwa Tea Estate for two night stay. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Huntingdon House (Double/twin Rooms), Satemwa Tea Estate - 2 nights

Day 4: Satemwa Tea Estate. Enjoy guided walks around the estates, play croquet on the lawn, take a tour of the coffee factory and do some tea tasting. Don't forget to take a trip up to the picnic spot for sundowners for a birds eye view of the estate and far beyond. Take a day trip to Mount Mulanje and do some hiking before heading back to the house to enjoy a home cooked meal and a tea/coffee related cocktail by the fire in the drawing room. (B,L,D)

Day 5: Satemwa Tea Estate - Liwonde National Park. Transfer to the Shire River where you will be met by the Kuthengo Camp staff and transferred via boat to the camp for the next two nights. This afternoon, enjoy a game drive to explore the wildlife of Liwonde National Park. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Kuthengo Camp (Tented Bush Chalet), Liwonde National Park - 2 nights

Day 6: Liwonde National Park. Enjoy a morning activity, choose from game drives, walking safaris or boating safaris! Late in the afternoon, enjoy a game drive. (B,L,D)

Day 7: Liwonde National Park - Lake Malawi National Park (Southern). Off to the Lake we go! Today you will be transferred to Kayak Africa Cottage in Cape Maclear for the boat transfer to Mumbo Island for a two night stay. (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Mumbo Island Lodge (Lakeview Chalet), Lake Malawi National Park - 2 nights

Day 8: Southern Lake Malawi. Take advantage of all the exciting water-based activities like snorkeling, scuba diving, kayaking or a sunset cruise. Or set off on foot into the depths of this uninhabited island and explore the natural wonders within. Embark on one of the many nature trails and discover hidden beaches, caves and exquisite birdlife before settling in for a sundowner gin & tonic on the famous 'pod rock' viewpoint. (B,L,D)

Day 9: Southern Lake Malawi - Senga Bay, Lake Malawi National Park. Today, transfer by boat back to the mainland to meet the local guide. Transfer to Whistler's Cottage in Senga Bay to catch the Blue Zebra boat to the private island for a three night stay. Blue Zebra Island Lodge is nestled on Nankoma Island, an unspoiled paradise under the protection of Lake Malawi National Park (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). (B,L,D)

Accommodation: Blue Zebra Island Lodge (Executive Chalet), Lake Malawi National Park - 3 nights

Day 10-11: Senga Bay, Lake Malawi National Park. Wake up to the sounds of nature, and Lake Malawi, with birds chirping. The lodge has a range of activity options to suit individuals, couples, families and friends. Take a gentle walk around the island - don't forget your binos (visit in the green season and you could spot the annually nesting African Pitta here!) Kayak round the island, snorkel, take a dip in the infinity pool or just relax on your private veranda. (B,L,D)

Day 12: Lake Malawi National Park - Lilongwe Kamuzu International Airport. Transfer by boat to the mainland and transfer to Lilongwe Kamuzu International Airport. (B)
