Visit an ostrich farm for a guided tour and light lunch, before continuing over the scenic Outeniqua Pass to George, and then onto Knysna, known as the oyster box of South Africa and the heart of the Garden Route. (B,L) Accommodation: Rex Hotel or similar, Knysna – 2 nights

Day 4: Knysna. Travel to Tsitsikamma National park today with time to enjoy a walk to Storms River Mouth. Make a stop for lunch on the way to Plettenberg Bay before a journey into the magical Knysna Forests, the stamping ground of the elusive Knysna elephants. Visit the Dalene Matthee big

Day 5: Knysna - Albertinia. Depart Knysna to travel via George and Mossel Bay to Albertinia, a town set against the backdrop of the majestic Langeberg Mountain Range. Enjoy an afternoon open vehicle game drive at a malaria-free private game reserve that is home to an abundance of animal and birdlife, including the Big 5.

Accommodation: Garden Route Game Lodge or similar, Albertinia – 1 night

Day 6: Albertinia - Hermanus. The safari adventure continues with an early morning open vehicle game drive. The expert guide will endeavour to spoil you with sightings of the Big 5, general game and prolific birdlife before continuing to Swellendam. This charming town was founded in 1745 and is famous for its youngberries, eclectic architecture and nature reserves, as well as outdoor activities. Continue to the seaside resort of Hermanus, which offers the best land-based whale watching in the world (Aug - Nov).

Accommodation: Misty Waves Hotel or similar, Hermanus – 1 night

Day 7: Hermanus - Cape Town. Depart Hermanus and travel to Franschhoek, a picturesque village surrounded by spectacular vineyards, where French Huquenots settled more than 300 years ago, bringing with them their age-old French wine and food culture. Tour through Franschhoek village, and learn about the fascinating history of the French Huguenots. Continue onto Cape Town, the oldest city in South Africa.
